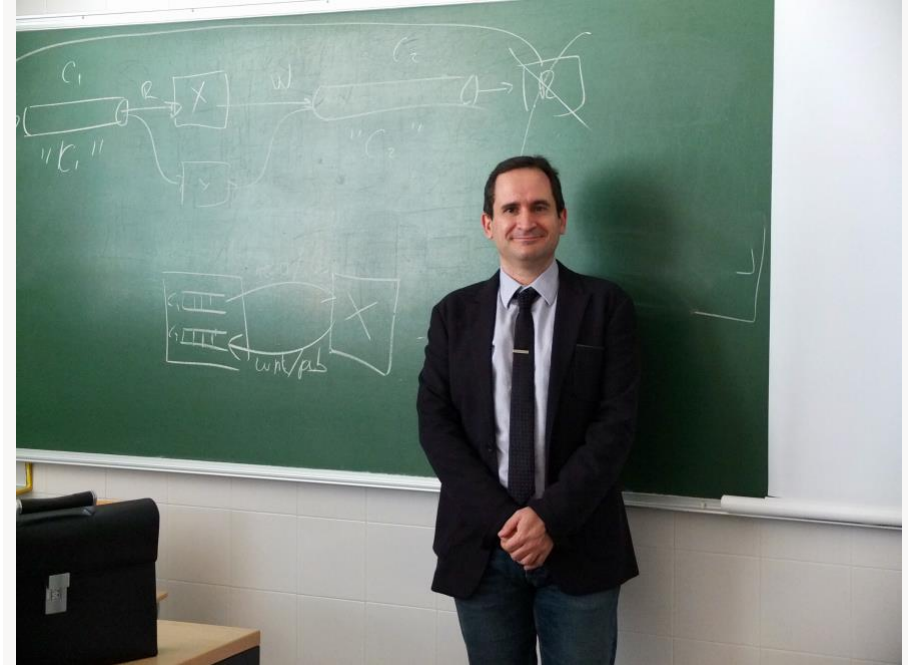

I received my Ph.D. in economics from the University of Zaragoza (Spain) in 2003 and have been teaching there since then. My teaching interests are primarily in the areas of economic growth, development and political economy.

My research is principally focused on the economics of education, studying how factors like social development, violence or educational inputs as new technologies determine academic success. The gender perspective is fundamental in these studies.

My research has also been dedicated to analyzing the links between growth, innovation, and human capital. For example, I have built different indicators of human capital and analyzed how this factor contributes to innovation and economic growth.

I have supervised research projects and Ph.D. theses in these areas, and my works have been published in leading international journals.

Finally, my long-lasting interest in Latin American economy has led me to be a visiting professor, researcher and consultant in several institutions in the region.

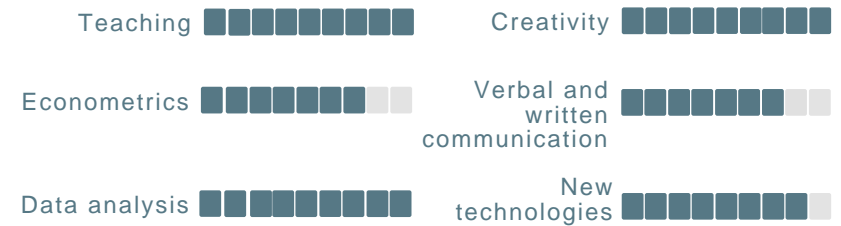
